Nick of Time Heart Healthy Screening

Feb. 2 8 a.m. - 5 p.m. JHS Gym

Established in memory of former JHS student, Nicholas Varrenti, the *Nick of Time Foundation*, in partnership with the University of Washington Medical Center will conduct heart screenings for our community. This screening will help detect hidden abnormalities in the heart which might otherwise lead to Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA).

Your JHS student watched a video about the Heart Healthy Screening process during 2nd period on Jan. 10 and 11. View the video.

To have your student screened, forms may be picked up during lunch period on Wednesday (1/12), Thursday (1/13), and Friday(1/14).

Registration occurs when students return their forms to the stage in the commons on Jan. 19 and Jan. 20.
